Day 1 Welcome to Prague

Day 4 Prague to Nuremberg

Day 7 Passau to Linz

Freechoice: Take an excursion to the medieval Czech town of Cesky Krumlov and discover its World Heritage-listed old city or journey to Salzburg and explore the birthplace of Mozart and the city backdrop for the film 'The Sound of Music'. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included)

Day 8 Melk to Dürnstein

Freechoice: Be guided through Melk's magnificent 18th century Benedictine Abbey. Alternatively, if you're feeling more active, embark on an enjoyable guided bike ride along the river from Melk to one of the most enchanting villages in the region, Dürnstein – at your own pace, of course. Or visit a local winery for a guided tour and tasting of its fine wines.

Day 9 Vienna

You'll have the opportunity to explore the greatest collection of Austrian art dating from the Middle Ages to the present day complemented by the work of international artists such as Claude Monet, Vincent van Gogh and Max Beckmann. The museum houses the world's largest collection of Gustav Klimt's paintings including the famous golden Art Nouveau icons the Kiss and Judith.

Enjoy an exclusive classical concert in Vienna's Palais Liechtenstein. With opulent interiors and pitch perfect acoustics, this is the ultimate music venue in a city renowned for its celebration of timeless music.
